
1 Plaintiffs and interested persons Wendi Abbott, Noni Anderson, Rich Bailey, Jeff  
2 Campbell, Susan Easley Conn, Anne Cox, Dave Ehrenkranz, Penny Ehrenkranz, Becky Frazier,  
3 Craig Frasier, Pratiti Fullerton, Daniel R. Garrison, Gigi Gordon, Jolene Jonas, Ernie  
4 Klostermann, Marjorie Kundiger, Robert Laliberte, Gary Liao, Judy Litwin, Mike Litwin, Tony  
5 Mandella, Jesus Ochoa-Madrueno, Harry Maurer, Palmer T. Olson, Brady Preheim, Rural  
6 Organizing Project, Kevin Wayne Walding, Marcy Westerling, and Pat Zimmerman  
7 ("Plaintiffs") have moved pursuant to ORCP 79 for a preliminary injunction against defendants  
8 Columbia County, County Counsel Sarah Hanson, County Commissioners Rita Bernhard, Earl  
9 Fisher, and Tony Hyde, and the Columbia County Board of Commissioners ("County  
10 Defendants"), and Columbia County District Attorney R. Stephen Atchison (County Defendants  
11 and defendant Atchison, collectively, "Defendants"), seeking to enjoin Defendants from  
12 enforcing Columbia County Initiative Measure 5-190 (2008) and Columbia County Ordinance  
13 No. 2008-6 (2008), until such time as the court enters final judgment in these cases as to all of  
14 the claims and all of the parties. County Defendants did not concede or oppose Plaintiffs' motion  
15 and did not submit arguments either for or against Plaintiffs' motion. Likewise, defendant  
16 Atchison took no position regarding the validity of the measure or the ordinance.

17 The Court concludes that it appears Plaintiffs are <sup>likely at least some of the</sup> entitled to the relief they seek  
18 and that enforcement of Columbia County Initiative Measure 5-190 (2008) and Columbia  
19 County Ordinance No. 2008-6 (2008) during this litigation would <sup>irreparably</sup> injure Plaintiffs. The Court,  
20 therefore, enjoins Defendants from enforcing Columbia County Initiative Measure 5-190 (2008)

1 and Columbia County Ordinance No. 2008-6 (2008), until such time as the Court enters final  
2 judgment in these consolidated cases as to all of the claims and all of the parties. Pursuant to  
3 ORCP 82 A(6), the Court waives security.
