12	3.	I presented myself at the front desk as an immigration attorney and inquired with	
13 14		Officer Mitchell about gaining entry to meet with immigrant detainees. He made an	
14		internal phone call and was instructed to give me the main phone number	
16		(503-843-4442) and to ask for Mr. Price. He instructed me to leave the facility and to

18		make calls from my vehicle in the parking lot.	
19	4.	From my vehicle, I called the main number and spoke with Ms. Baumeister. She told	
20		me Mr. Price was in a meeting, and I left him a voicemail at approximately 2:30PM.

6 7	7.	Ms. Baker also informed me that I would need to obtain permission from Immigration
8		and Customs Enforcement (ICE) as well. She suggested I call Michael Louie from the
9		Portland ICE office. I called the main phone number for the Portland ICE office and
10		left a message.
11	8.	On Thursday, June 21, 2018, I was contacted by Sheridan Pro Bono Project and
12		
13		ACLU Oregon staff who requested that I meet them again at FDC. Upon knowledge
14		and belief, they had been given authorization from ICE to meet with immigrant
15		detainees.
16	9.	At approximately 12:30PM, I drove myself into the FDC complex behind Ian
17 18		Philabaum, authorized paralegal for Stephen Manning, and Leland Baxter-Neal,
19		ACLU of Oregon staff attorney. Both of our vehicles were stopped by a gate closure
20		at the security checkpoint. Our vehicles were approached by Officer Palominos and
21		two males wearing unmarked desert camouflage uniforms who identified themselves
22		
23		as FDC staff and offered their first names only. Officer Palominos spoke first with
24		Philabaum and Baxter-Neal, and then approached my vehicle.
25	10.	Officer Palominos stated that there were already attorneys from the public defender's
26		office inside the FDC facility who were authorized by ICE and that no other attorneys
27		would be allowed entry today. I responded that I had met with Ms. Baker yesterday

20	13.	I handed Officer Palominos my business card and Philabaum and Baxter-Neal wrote

22		their names on the back of the card. Officer Palominos told us to exit the complex and
23		drive to a gravel parking lot down the road and wait 10 minutes while they turned in
24		our names. He said we should drive back up after 10 minutes and he would have an
25		answer for us about whether we would be allowed inside.
